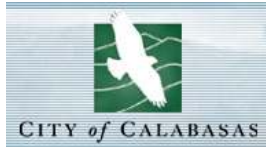




The City of Calabasas, California Awards Contract to Edgesoft for Citywide Implementation of the Enterprise Land Management System (eLMS™)

The City's requirements for the new application included integrating the Community Development, Public Works and Finance departments with a unified system that met all the departmental needs; reducing the time spent processing the submittal of plans and issuance of permits; and implementing a solution that has the ability to evolve and grow along with the City.
